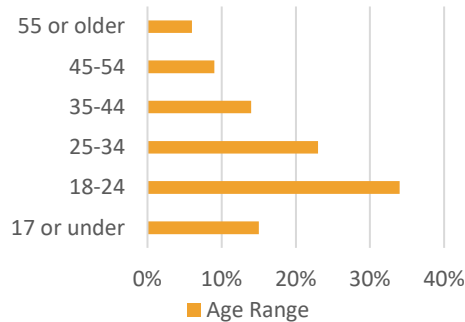
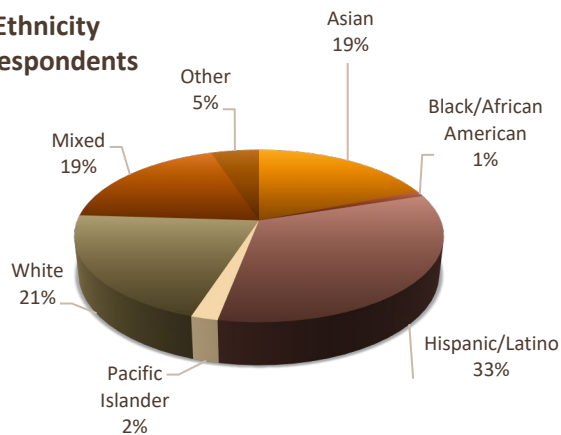


Community opinions on Smoke-Free Policies in Outdoor Spaces

One hundred and ten (110) Public Opinion Surveys were collected from the community in Cypress, California from June 10 to October 29, 2024. Eighty-two percent of the respondents are registered to vote. Respondents identified on a scale from 1-10 how important having smoke-free outdoor spaces were to them. On average the level of importance was 7.7.

91% of the POS respondents would support a law that prohibits tobacco use in outdoor spaces.

Results

100%

- Believe people have the right to breathe clean air in outdoor public spaces

93%

- Would vote for a City Council or Mayoral candidate who supports a smoke-free outdoor spaces policy

90%

- Are more likely to visit public places that do not allow smoking

69%

- Believe people have the right to smoke/vape in outdoor public spaces.

77%

- Have been bothered by secondhand smoke in an outdoor area

43%

- Believe people will stop smoking if "No Smoking" Signs are posted in outdoor spaces

47%

- Are comfortable asking people to NOT smoke near me in outdoor public spaces

11%

- Currently smoke/vape or use a tobacco product
